# Gender Equality for Economic Recovery

In the current context of consolidation of growth and economic recovery after one of the most severe recessions in recent decades, **gender equality** is presented not only as the cornerstone of any democratic society but also as a **prerequisite for growth and economic development**. It is essential at this time, to ensure that social cohesion, equal opportunities and gender equality are present in the budget policy responses applied by the public authorities.
